IMMUNIZATIONS FOR 2018-2019

All immunization records must be up to date **BEFORE** school starts August 20.

- ▶ **Grade 4** has been added to the requirement for **two (2) doses of varicella.**
- ▶ **Grade 6** has been added to the requirement for **three (3) doses of oral and/or inactivated polio** vaccine. At least one dose must be received on or after the 4th birthday.
- ▶ **Grade 12** has been added to the requirement for one **(1) Tdap booster** (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis). A dose on or after the 7th birthday will meet this requirement.
