EARLY DISMISSAL FRIDAY

This Friday is an early dismissal day for all students, K3-Grade 12. Day Care will operate on their regular schedule for registered day care students.

DRESS CODE REMINDERS

Remember these areas in our *7-12th grade dress code* policies.

- ▶ Grade 7-12th girls skirt lengths must come to the bottom of the knees *even when wearing leggings or tights underneath* the skirt.
- ▶ Tennis shoes are not allowed.
- ▶ Girls socks, leggings, or tights must be blue, black, grey, or white.
- ▶ Boys socks must be blue, black, grey, brown or white.
- ▶ Shirts worn under sweaters or jackets must be the same colors as uniform shirts—solid blue, grey, or white.

These areas also apply to 1st-6th graders:

- ▶ Shirts worn under sweaters, jackets or jumpers must be the same colors as uniform shirts—solid blue, grey, or white. No prints, patterns, or colors that are not uniform colors can be worn. This applies to girls and boys.
- ▶ Girls dresses and skirts must come at least to the top of the knees even when wearing leggings or tights underneath. Watch hem lengths if your student has grown during the school year!
