### IMMUNIZATIONS FOR 2018-2019

The SC Department of Health and Environmental control has declared the following minimum requirements are necessary for a child to be admitted to any SC school, K5-Grade 12, for the 2018-2019 school year. **All immunization records must be up to date BEFORE school starts on August 20.**

- ▶ **Grade 4** has been added to the requirement for **two (2) doses of varicella**.
- ▶ **Grade 6** has been added to the requirement for **three (3) doses of oral and/or inactivated polio** vaccine with at least one dose received on or after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- ▶ **Grade 12** has been added to the requirement for one **(1) Tdap booster** (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis). A dose on or after the 7<sup>th</sup> birthday will meet this requirement.
