Tuition \$148/week includes snacks. Summer activity fee \$60

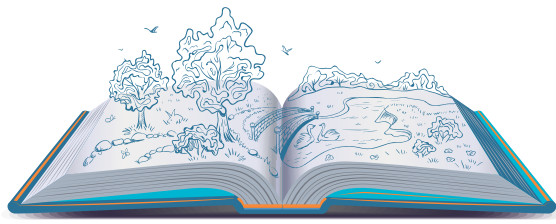
Children may bring a lunch or purchase a lunch ticket.
