### **NEW IMMUNIZATION FOR 7<sup>TH</sup> GRADERS**

Remember that students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade in 2010 are required to have a dose of Tdap vaccine. DHEC is encouraging parents to have children immunized early to avoid the end-of-summer rush.

Immunizations may be obtained from personal physicians or the from county health departments. A copy of the updated SC DHEC Form 1148 must be included in permanent records for all rising 7<sup>th</sup> graders.
